LOST PET

- 1) First, search your property thoroughly.
- 2) Walk the neighborhood
- 3) CALL the Canine Adoption Center, Animal Friends, and local vets.
- 4) Post flyers about your lost pet
- 5) Put a free ad in the Dominion Post
- 6) Check the newspaper "found" ads

FOUND PET

- 1) Ask around the neighborhood.
- 2) Look for Identification: name tag, rabies tag, tax tag
- 3) Take the animal to the shelter/vets to scan for a microchip.
- 4) Contact the Canine Adoption Center, Animal Friends, and local vets to report the animal to them.
- 5) Place a free "found pet" ad in your local paper.
- 6) Look for posters in the area that may be posted for the pet

What Can I Do?

SPAY/NEUTER YOUR PET

Spaying/neutering reduces overpopulation and some animal illness such as cancer.

FOSTER A PET

Provide a loving, short term home for a pet waiting for adoption

BE A VOLUNTEER

Volunteer with us or another animal group.

The Canine Adoption Center is funded by our County Commission. We are animal control in the city limits and we are dog wardens for the entire county.

There is a leash law that we enforce for the entire county. Dogs must be contained on your property at all times and on a leash while walking.

We are the only facility that takes animals from the public. You must show proof that you are from Monongalia County when dropping off animal.

The Canine Adoption Center is a mandatory spay/neuter facility!

We are so happy! All animals are now altered before they are put up for adoption.
